**** DON'T FORGET PRE-REQUISITES ****

In addition to the following business courses, you must complete the following requirements to graduate:

- Meet College of Business Continuance Requirements
- Pass MS Competency Requirement (ACC 167 & 168; or ACC 189.67 & 189.68 or ACC 166; or ACS 150 or equivalent)
- Earn Cs in ALL your required business classes, a 2.0 major and cumulative ISU GPA.
- Complete General Education Requirements (University Studies OR Associate's of Arts/Science degree OR I.A.I. – transfer general education)
- Earn at least 120 hours toward graduation
- Earn 60 non-business hours (including MQM 100 and up to 9 ECO hours)
- Complete Global Studies Requirement (AMALI courses in ISU Gen Ed qualify)
- Pass the University Writing Exam – COST \$7 – sign up on STAR+/SIAS for ENG 189.99 or go to 107 Moulton Hall
- Pass the US and IL Constitution Exams – COST \$3.50 – 346 Fell Hall – go to <http://iilt.ilstu.edu/rbradley/constitution.htm> for study materials
- Apply for Graduation – COST \$20 – 107 Moulton Hall or Student Accounts

CAREER SPECIALTY SEQUENCE COURSES = 4 elective courses / 12 hours

Students may elect up to 12 hours in another specialized area with advice and approval of the Academic Advisor and Department Chair. Elective hours cannot include more than 6 hours of Accounting electives. Normally, these courses will not include courses already completed before approval of the plan of study.
