Required Courses (9 hours):

- FIL 185** **Legal, Ethical and Social Environment of Business** 3 hours
 (formerly FIL 208)
 Prerequisite: ECO 105 or ECO 101/102 or ECO 103

- FIL 240** **Business Finance** 3 hours
 Prerequisites:
 (60 hrs, ACC 131 and 132, MQM 100 or ECO 138, ECO 105 or ECO 101 and ECO 102)
OR
 Math majors may substitute **MAT 280** for this requirement.

- FIL 250** Introduction to Risk and Insurance (60 hours) 3 hours

Three courses from the following (9 hours):

✓	Chosen Insurance Minor Elective (see below for choices)

- FIL 350** Property Insurance (“C” or better in FIL 250)
- FIL 351** Life and Health Insurance (“C” or better in FIL 250)
- FIL 352** Liability Insurance (“C” or better in FIL 250)
- FIL 353** Financial Planning (“C” or better in FIL 208, 240 and 250)
- FIL 354** Risk Management (“C” or better in FIL 350 or FIL 352)

Other Requirements:

- Minor coursework cannot be taken PASS/FAIL.
- All 200-level business courses require 60 hours for enrollment.
- A student may only repeat a course once.
- Non-Business majors, including Minors, are limited to 30 hours of business coursework; therefore, planning should include the prerequisites. Registration will be blocked at 24 hours, requiring individual overrides for 2 additional courses. Please consult with a business advisor if this policy affects your registration.
- Students completing MAT 280 in place of FIL 240 will need to notify the Insurance advisor for the proper substitution to take place.
