- ◆ Halifax is the capital of Nova Scotia.
- ◆ Population 350,000

DALHOUSIE UNIVERSITY:

PREREQUISITES:

- ◆ Graduate students must have a 3.0 GPA.

HOUSING:

- ◆ Generally exchange students live on the 32nd and 33rd floors of Fenwick Place sharing a kitchen, washrooms and laundry facilities.
