



# A BUSINESS SEMESTER IN EUROPE



## STUDY IN PADERBORN, GERMANY



**As a participant of this program, you will have the opportunity to study business together with German students in the same business courses--and all of this for less than what it would cost for a semester at Illinois State University.**

### **The Business Program:**

You can study at Paderborn without any prior knowledge of German. You will start your studies at Paderborn with a three-month German Language Course beginning tentatively January 3<sup>rd</sup>. The three month German Language course will meet 20 hours/week and cost an additional 185 Euro.

Depending on your level of German at the end of the language program before the semester, you may choose to enroll in business courses in either English or German. The University of Paderborn offers a variety of business courses in English, among them Strategic Marketing Management, Economic Policy in Germany, and Quality Management in Europe. These courses are designed for all business students rather than just for Americans. If your German is at a level where you can follow the lectures in German but feel uncomfortable writing papers and exams in German, you may in some cases do papers and exams in English. ### **Academic Credit:**

The courses you take at Paderborn will be articulated to ISU as a part of your transcript and cumulative GPA. Proper selection of courses should allow you to graduate on time. And you will know before you go how they will count. No surprises here. Make sure you see your advisor to design your program.

### **Housing:**

The University will help you with housing. You will have the option of living in a dorm, with German students in an apartment, or with a family. You can decide.

### **Cost:**

See program budget for details. The estimated budget is \$8,814.13. This includes room and board, airfare, OISP\* fees, ISU reduced tuition & insurance, international student ID card, local transportation, books and supplies, and personal expenses. Financial aid is available to those who qualify
