Edmund & Jane Endowed Scholarship

One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a qualified business student at Illinois State University during the 2011/2012 academic year. The award is to be used for educational expenses and will be distributed over the 2011/2012 academic year in two installments; \$500 each semester. Qualified students must:

- Be an incoming freshman or a current College of Business student in good standing at Illinois State University.
- Demonstrate academic achievement, as evidenced by:
 - Incoming freshman – a cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.25 on a 4.00 scale and graduated in the upper quarter of his/her high school class and/or have a composite ACT score of 25 or higher.
 - Continuing ISU student – a cumulative ISU GPA of 3.25 or higher.
- Demonstrate an unmet need for financial aid as determined by Illinois State Financial Aid Office and/or federal regulation and/or personal circumstances.

As part of the application process, students are asked to:

- Write a 250 word essay discussing why they're interested in a professional career in business, why they selected their major, and how a scholarship will impact their academic future (financial need is a primary factor in the selection process).
- Submit a copy of their resume
- Submit at least one letter of reference.
